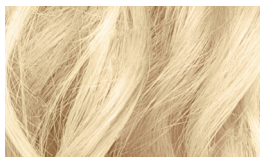


Intensive Lash & Brow Color and Blending Guide

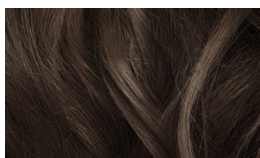
If your hair color before tinting is:

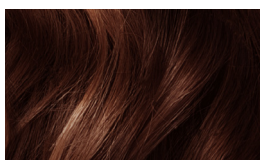
Copper Blonde, Copper Gold Blonde, Strawberry Blonde



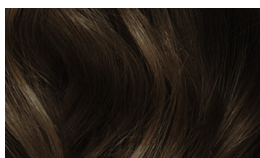
Dark Ash Blonde



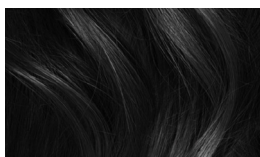
Light Brown, Medium Brown

We suggest using the following Intensive colors.

Use Graphite or Middle Brown

Use Middle Brown, Graphite, or $\frac{3}{4}$ Middle Blonde + $\frac{1}{4}$ Middle Brown

Use Natural or Middle Blonde

Use Middle Brown, Brown, or $\frac{1}{2}$ Middle Brown + $\frac{1}{2}$ Brown

Use $\frac{1}{2}$ Brown + $\frac{1}{2}$ Graphite or $\frac{1}{2}$ Middle Brown + $\frac{1}{2}$ Graphite

Use Brown or $\frac{1}{2}$ Brown + $\frac{1}{2}$ Deep Black

Use Deep Black
*If you choose this color, you must ensure it is what the guest wants before applying.

Use Ash Grey or Middle Blonde
